The ongoing in-person workshop marks the fourth phase of the Capacity Building Program. The third phase of the program, concluded in March 2024, featured masterclasses for the heads and representatives of five departments, including the Department of Academic Affairs and Evaluation. The current fourth phase, a two-day zone-wise workshop, is designed to further handhold the participants of the masterclass to foster an inclusive learning environment for students with Specific Learning Disability (SLD).
