Under the aegis of Malaviya Mission Teacher Training Programme (MMTTP)

As India assumes an increasingly prominent role in the world, there is an urgent need to inculcate leadership development in higher educational institutions (HEI) both among students and faculty. In pursuit of this goal, the Indian Institute of Management (IIM) Mumbai is offering 5-day residential programme on “Nurturing Future Leadership” during 11-15 March 2024.

The programme is envisioned to make “**Everyone a Leader**” to be able to create an empowered workforce with an open and participative culture.

The objectives of the programme are:

- i. To build **ecosystem** to **inculcate leadership skills** in **faculty members at levels early in their career** to advance both individual and organizational goals.
- ii. To be a **broad-based** leadership development programme (for all faculty across all levels)
