Certification:

Upon successfully completing the programme, the participant shall be awarded a certificate by IIT Madras under the aegis of the Malaviya Mission Teacher Training Programme (MMTTP).

Financials:

The first batch of the program is being fully funded by the Ministry of Education, GoI. This is a residential program, and IIT Madras will take care of the participants' on-campus board and lodging (single occupancy). However, the travel costs of the participants shall need to be borne by the respective Institutions.

If the institutions choose to nominate more than 2 participants, they will be required to cover the total cost (including training and travel expenses) for those additional participants. The total program fees per additional participant in a batch for five days are Rs 50,000/- plus GST.

Please note: 100% of the payment for additional participants must be done in advance before the commencement of the program.
