Background

The NEP 2020 emphasizes the importance of skilled faculty in Higher Education. Capacity building for teachers is prioritized, utilizing existing mechanisms like UGC-HRDCs and Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching Centres. Continuous professional development is crucial given the evolving nature of education. The Nurturing Future Leadership Programme (NFLP) is designed to equip faculty members with the necessary skills and competencies to excel in both current and future leadership roles within Higher Education Institutions (HEIs). The programme focuses on developing technical, managerial, and interpersonal skills essential for effective leadership in shaping the education landscape for future generations.

IIM Bodh Gaya

Situated in the Land of Enlightenment, Bodh Gaya, the Indian Institute of Management Bodh Gaya is an epitome of profound knowledge and academic excellence. IIM Bodh Gaya was founded by the Indian Ministry of Education in 2015. The institution lives by its core values of Responsibility, Honesty, Integrity, Lifelong Learning, and Mindfulness, with the goal of developing mindful and socially responsible leaders.

The institute started with one flagship PGP programme with an initial batch of 30 students. Currently, it is home to over 1,400 students across five long-duration residential programmes from 293 cities, 26 states in India, and beyond, placing it among the top five IIMs in terms of student enrollment. The permanent campus of IIM Bodh Gaya phase 1 has been constructed over an area of 60,378 square meters and boasts of world-class facilities.
