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Introduction

The world of academia calls upon academics to deploy skillsets best honed with focus and solitude. Intellectual rigor, convergent thinking, deep focus, and single-minded pursuit of academic excellence are sine qua non for meaningful progress through the academic echelons. These well-honed cognitive skills hold the academics in good stead through their journey in the rigorous world of academia.

Administrative responsibilities, however, require the erstwhile academics to function in roles that need a different skill set. As heads of teams or institutions, academic administrators must deal with scores of people and rapidly move across varied tasks quite far from their specific areas of expertise. In addition to academic excellence and integrity, this role now requires an arsenal of skills such as teamwork, emotional intelligence, negotiation, and leadership skills for leading self and others to organizational excellence.

Besides administrative acumen, these positions also call for familiarity with the statutory and regulatory requirements as well as government processes on procurement and general financial rules (GFR). An administrator is expected to be familiar with the intricacies of recruitment processes, tendering and contracting, judicial matters and litigation, RTI, and POSH.

The need to bridge this gap for the academic administrator has been appreciated for some time. Malaviya Mission Teacher Training Programme is a concerted effort to equip the potential academic administrator with the appropriate skill set for this new role.

The Centre for Public Management, IIM Raipur has, therefore, curated this programme based on the following three pillars:

- 1. Leading self
- 2. Nurturing others and institution building
- 3. Administrative skills

Center for Public Management at IIM Raipur

The Center for Public Management of IIM Raipur aims to provide curated content of conceptual frameworks and their practical public sector-related applications for building the capacity of public functionaries at various levels. Participants also gain a valuable understanding of development and management concepts from classroom discussions and extensive interaction with fellow participants from other organizations.

- To expand the pool of potential leaders for the range of leadership positions
- To prepare faculty to contribute effectively and proactively in collective decision-making,
- Shared governance, developing initiatives, problem-solving.
- Enabling institute administration to assess the leadership quality of their faculty through this programme.

Pedagogy

The pedagogy of the programs includes group exercises, focus group discussions, exercises, case studies, experiential learning, interactive lectures, classroom discussions, interactions with senior functionaries of the host institute, industry leaders, and field trips if required.

Assessment and Certification

Upon successfully completing the programme, the participant shall be awarded a certificate by IIM Raipur under the aegis of the Malaviya Mission Teacher Training Programme (MMTTP).

Upon successful conclusion of the program, the anticipated benefits include:

- Enhanced proficiency in leadership skills, team management, communication skills, and critical thinking among participants.
- Establishment of a reservoir of proficient institutional leaders through comprehensive training.
- Enhancement of the administrative capabilities of higher education institutions.


