
## **IIT Gandhinagar**

# NURTURING FUTURE LEADERSHIP PROGRAMME

This benefits not just the individuals involved but the entire nation.

Aligned with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, which emphasizes faculty excellence and institutional leadership, the Nurturing Future Leadership Program (NFLP) is a key initiative under the Malviya Mission Teacher Training Programme (MMTTP). This five-day residential camp focuses on experiential learning, aiming to empower faculty at all career stages to build an inclusive, participatory, and innovative culture where "Everyone is a Leader."

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

Regular/ permanent faculty from Centrally-Funded Institutes, State Public University and Private HEIs., duly nominated by the Directors/Vice Chancellors.



#### **CERTIFICATION**

Participants will be awarded certificates by IIT Gandhinagar under the aegis of MMTTP upon successful completion of NFLP.



#### **OTHER DETAILS**

The program is fully funded by the Ministry of Education, GoI, for up to 2 faculty members from 1 institute. IIT Gandhinagar will arrange for boarding and lodging of participants, however, the travel expenses of participants shall be borne by the respective institutes. The institutes can nominate more than 2 participants but will have to pay the total cost (with a program fee of Rs. 50,000 inclusive of GST each) for those additional participants.
