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Course Introduction:

Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) are fundamental building blocks in shaping a nation's future, particularly in today's fastest-growing economies. This role is crucial as HEIs prepare young citizens to excel in a dynamic world full of opportunities and challenges. To excel, HEIs must be led by proactive educationists who adapt to environmental changes and pioneer innovative educational strategies.

The Nurturing Future Leadership Programme (NFLP) aims to empower faculty members in current and prospective leadership roles at HEIs, enhancing their technical, managerial, and interpersonal skills for effective future leadership. Aligned with the National Educational Policy, the program offers a tailored and transformative educational leadership and management experience.

The NFLP offered by the Indian Institute of Management Visakhapatnam (IIMV) for the National Institute of Educational Planning and Administration (NIEPA) allows faculty members employed at all levels in Indian HEIs to transform themselves from scholars to leaders. This five-day residential programme will provide the candidates with:

- **Skills** to lead effectively across educational institutions.
- **Knowledge** about themselves and their context to improve their ability to get things done.
- **Confidence** in their own role to unlock their leadership potential.

Course Objectives:

The participants of this program will be trained to provide leadership as educators, administrators, and facilitators of educational change within educational institutions and communities.

1. Develop a deep understanding of the knowledge, skills, and attributes necessary to function as an effective leader in academic institutions
2. Identify the challenges and levers of managing and leading organizations.
3. Imbibe strategic thinking to lead organizational change and inspire high-performing teams in HEIs.
4. Appreciate the nuances of cross-functional coordination and develop conflict resolution and consensus-building techniques.

Target Audience:

This programme is designed for emerging leaders aiming to enhance their role in the success of their educational institute. It is open to permanent faculty from any discipline with at least three years of teaching experience in Centrally-Funded Institutes, Institutes of National Importance, State Public Universities, and Private HEIs.

The programme is ideal for faculty members seeking leadership roles in formal and informal educational settings. Early career faculty identified for leadership responsibilities, being groomed for promotions, or advancing towards leadership positions will benefit from this programme.

Program Fee

The program fee is Rs.50,000/- per participant + GST (18%). will be borne by the Ministry of Education. This is a residential program, and IIMV will take care of the on-campus board and lodging (single occupancy) for the participants. However, the travel costs of the participants shall need to be borne by the respective institutions themselves.

Pedagogy:

To capture the pragmatic, action-oriented nature of a leader's role in today's dynamic educational environment, we will incorporate a blend of case discussions, readings, lectures, role-plays, and other interactive exercises. While the case method remains a key approach, it will be supplemented as needed to provide a comprehensive learning experience. The skills this course aims to develop can be sharpened only through practice, requiring participants to engage with 'real world' scenarios in the classroom. Case discussions, along with other pedagogical tools, help simulate these scenarios as closely as possible.

The Institute

The **Indian Institute of Management Visakhapatnam (IIMV)** belongs to the prestigious IIM family of business schools. It is a new generation IIM, set up by the Government of India in September 2015. At 26th place among the business schools pan-India in the National Institutional Ranking Framework 2024 of the Government of India, it is ahead of all new-generation IIMs established in 2015/2016.

The Institute has two campuses with state-of-the-art facilities in the “City of Destiny”, Visakhapatnam. Its temporary/transit campus is located in the salubrious precincts of Andhra University. The permanent campus, a world-class GRIHA-5 Star rated facility on approx. 241 acres of land is located at Gambheeram Village, Anandapuram Mandal, about 25 kilometers from the temporary campus, on the National Highway (NH) 16 to Kolkata.

Prof. M Shameem Jawed

Associate Professor, Finance & Accounting

FPM (Ph.D.) IIM Indore; BE (Mechanical Engg.)

Prof. Shameem, an alumnus of IIM Indore with a Ph.D. in Finance & Accounting, is currently an Associate Professor at IIM Visakhapatnam. With a diverse background in academia and industry, including roles at MDI, IIMV, and as a consultant at SunGard (now FIS), he specializes in Corporate Finance, Financial Analytics, Cost Management, and Startup Finance.

Trained twice at Harvard Business School in participant-centered learning and Case teaching, Prof. Shameem brings a dynamic teaching approach, having delivered over 1,500 hours of instruction at leading institutions. As the founding director of IIMV FIELD, he spearheaded the development of the institute's startup incubator, which has supported over 180 startups since 2018.

His leadership includes designing and spearheading unique academic programs, such as the PGPMCI (a modular Diploma-cum-MBA for CFTI students) and the MGNF, where fellows work with 76 district collectors across India on skill development and entrepreneurship initiatives over two years. Additionally, he played a key role in securing funding and developing pre-incubation, incubation, and acceleration

programs, in partnership with bodies like MeitY, MSDE, DST, NITI Aayog, and private sector collaborators such as MTAR, NBCC, and S2Tech.

Dr. Anuradha has obtained her PhD from XLRI, Jamshedpur. She completed her Master's degree in Psychology from University of Delhi. Before enrolling for the PhD program, she worked as a counsellor and psychology teacher at a reputed school and has also headed a USAID funded project for education of slum children in Delhi. Dr Anuradha was previously employed with Great Lakes Institute of Management, Chennai as Assistant Professor in the OB-HRM area. She has taught courses on Organizational Structure, Design & Change, Groups in Organizations, Individual Behaviour within Organizations, Introduction to Empirical Research and Stress Management to MBA and Executive students. She has published research in various academic journals. She also regularly writes articles on relevant behavioural topics in the popular press. Dr. Anuradha is an active trainer and has provided training to officers in organizations like Indian Oil Corporation; Eisai Pharmaceuticals Pvt Ltd.; National Academy of Customs, Indirect Taxes and Narcotics; Madras Chambers of Commerce and Industry; Income Tax Department (Vizag); CBSE and TEQIP. Currently she is the Chairperson of the Executive Education Programs at IIM Visakhapatnam.
