## About the Program

As India advances toward becoming a global leader in education and innovation, higher education institutions (HEIs) are called upon to cultivate visionary and capable leaders who can shape the future of academia.

The Nurturing Future Leadership Programme (NFLP), under the Malaviya Mission – Teachers Training Programme (MMTTP) of the Ministry of Education, Government of India, is designed to build this leadership capacity among faculty in HEIs.

Anchored in the principles of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, the programme focuses on developing academic leaders who combine institutional insight, empathy, and strategic foresight – those who can guide their institutions toward excellence, inclusion, and innovation.

## About GIM

## Objectives

The programme envisions a culture where *“Everyone is a Leader”*—creating empowered, participative, and forward-looking institutions. The NFLP seeks to:

- Build an ecosystem that nurtures leadership skills early in a faculty member’s career.
- Expand the pool of potential institutional leaders.
- Enable faculty to participate effectively in shared governance, decision-making, and institutional problem-solving.
- Support institutions in assessing and developing leadership potential within their faculty.

## Why Participate

Effective leadership is no longer confined to formal administrative roles. It is reflected in the ability to inspire teams, shape institutional culture, and contribute meaningfully to collective decision-making.

The NFLP at GIM is an immersive five-day journey that helps faculty members identify and refine their own leadership potential through case studies, role plays/simulation, and field activities.

Under the guidance of distinguished faculty, participants will engage with peers from diverse institutions across India, and gain insights from experienced academic and management leaders.



## Core Competencies Developed

The NFLP curriculum is designed to strengthen leadership across six key dimensions:

- **Teamwork:**  
Building trust, managing people, resolving conflict, and driving change.
- **Communication:**  
Active listening, empathy, public speaking, and persuasive presentation.
- **Self-Management:**  
Self-awareness, resilience, stress management, and lifelong learning.
- **Professional Skills:**  
Negotiation, financial acumen, inclusivity, strategic thinking, and managing change.
- **Critical Thinking:**  
Creative problem-solving, decision-making, and analytical reasoning.
- **Conscientious Citizenship:**  
Ethical and authentic leadership, sustainability, and advancing equity and inclusion.



## Programme Design

### ➤ Eligibility:

Regular/permanent faculty members from Centrally Funded, State Public Funded, and Private HEIs nominated by their Head of Institution (Director / Vice-Chancellor / Principal). Maximum of two (2) per institution.

### ➤ Fees:

₹ 50,000 per participant

The programme fee is fully sponsored by the Ministry of Education, Government of India. The funding includes tuition, accommodation, and meals. The travel costs to and from GIM are to be borne by the sponsoring institution.

### ➤ Duration:

5-Day Residential Programme (Including one half-day field visit and a networking dinner)
