IIM Bodhgaya

Situated in the Land of Enlightenment Bodh Gaya, the Indian Institute of Management Bodh Gaya (IIM Bodh Gaya), affectionately known as #EnlighteningIIM, stands as a modern epitome of profound knowledge and academic excellence. This prestigious institution is not just geographically, but also spiritually and academically, rooted in the land of Nalanda. IIM Bodh Gaya was founded in 2015 with a vision to create socially responsible mindful leaders under the Ministry of Education of India at the land of enlightenment: Bodh Gaya.

The first batch started with 30 students with only one flagship PGP program in 2015-16. At present, it has more than 1,400 students across five long duration residential programmes which include representation from 293 cities, 26 states across India & abroad which makes us among top five amongst IIM's with respect to students enrolment. IIM Bodh Gaya Core Values are Responsibility, Honesty and Integrity, Life-long Learning, and Mindfulness. The permanent campus of IIM Bodh Gaya phase 1 has been constructed over an area of 60,378 square meters. IIM Bodh Gaya acts as a catalyst in promoting internationalization facilitating the bilateral flow of knowledge and values through exchange programs, faculty engagements and research tie-ups through partnerships with 37 business schools and universities spread across the 05 continents.

Nurturing Future Leadership Programme

In order to nurture faculty at different level particularly at the early stage of their career, thereby creating a pool of potential leaders for generational transition, the Ministry of Education has conceptualised faculty leadership development programme namely 'Nurturing Future Leadership Program', under the aegis of Malaviya Mission Teacher Training Programme (MMTTP). This is a prestigious, selection-based leadership development programme which is open for all levels of faculty from Centrally-Funded Institutes, State Public University and Private HEIs. This 5 day residential programme will be delivered by eminent institutes having expertise in running management/ leadership courses.



Programme Objectives

1. To build ecosystem to inculcate leadership skills in faculty members at levels early in their career to advance both individual and organizational goals
2. To expand the pool of potential leaders for the range of leadership positions
3. To prepare faculty to contribute effectively and proactively in collective decision-making, shared governance, developing initiatives, problem solving
4. Training of faculty through a comprehensive and rigorous selection process to ensure only the most qualified individuals participate.
5. Enabling institute administration to assess leadership quality of their faculty through this program

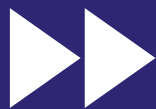


Expected Outcomes:
